



ASSURANCE OF SALVATION

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

James 1:17

Once granted to you salvation can never be taken away or lost. God never goes back on His Word. There are many false doctrines about losing your salvation, but they are all a lie. The Bible is very clear, you can never lose the gift of eternal life. A Christian is a person who has, by faith trusted in Jesus Christ as their only Lord and Saviour of sin.

2 Corinthians 5:17 says, “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.” If you could lose salvation, then the new creation would have to be cancelled out and the old creation would return. It is important to note that the Bible does not teach sinless perfection during earthly life. However, Scripture does teach that a saved child of God will not be controlled by sin nor will they continually sin. Romans 5:1 says, “Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.” Romans 8:30 continues, “Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.”

Christians have been redeemed through Christ, by faith. As you have been redeemed you have been bought for a price. For you to lose salvation God would have to refund the payment. In John 3:16, God promises eternal life to all those who trust in Christ. God never changes His mind nor goes back on His promises. Salvation is eternal, never ending.

After your salvation, the Devil will try to beguile you and try to make you doubt your eternal gift from God. He does this by tempting you to sin and question God’s promises. One of the Devils favourites is to make you think that now you are saved you can lose your salvation and your works are part of you keeping or maintaining your salvation.

The evil one will try to make you believe that good works maintain your salvation. He will use ungodly people around you to influence his negative impact on your spiritual life. The Devil can also use godly people to trick you. Beware of those who try to mislead you. The best defence against this attack is God’s Word. The Bible is a great weapon against falsehood. The doubtful thoughts that Satan implants in the mind may start to sound logical, “do this and get this in return.”

Salvation does not work this way, for if it did then Jesus died in vain on the cross. On the cross Jesus paid the price of sin on behalf of all mankind. It was God’s sovereign will in action. God in His mercy before the foundation of the world chose to redeem sinners like you and me.

There are many branches of the Christian faith who have started to listen to the voice of Satan. This is why many Christians never look happy, joyful, or content with their lives. They have been tricked by Satan to think they need to do good things to be acceptable when they
