THE IMPORTANCE OF CHURCH MEMBERSHIP

So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

Romans 12:5

It is very important that Christians attach themselves to a good Bible-believing church. Before you decide which church to join read their article of faith and if permitted the church constitution. This is important because by reading these documents you will have a good understanding of how the church is run and what the church teaches. The Bible does not directly address formal church membership, but there are Scriptures that strongly suggest that church membership was part of the early church. In Acts 2:47 the Bible says, "Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved."

Church membership is important as this helps Christians with accountability and growth. The main reason why we ought to be part of a local church is because God has commanded us to have fellowship with other believers and to be under the teaching of a local church and the Elders of a local church fellowship. Each member of the church has an obligation to one another. God has designed the church for the teaching of believers, building them up in faith, rebuking errors, and false doctrine, encouraging believers, to provoke one another to do good works and guiding them in truth. The church is the body of Christ on earth.

By joining a local church, you are committing yourself to that fellowship for the well-being of the other members and yourself. Christians ought to join a local church as a step of obedience and to glorify God. Church membership is also important for our discipleship and edification.
